Leyla Fröhlich-Güzelsoy studied medicine at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg, the University of Columbia Missouri (USA), the University of Witwatersrand, Johannesburg (RSA) and the University of Luzern (Switzerland). Between 1998 and 2001 she worked as a physician in a clinic for surgery and a fertility center. Since 2003 she is constantly teaching nurses, physiotherapists, medical students and medical lays in basic sciences, medical ethics and first aid. Between 2006 and 2007 she completed a course in „Medical Ethics Advisor“ at the Clinic of Nuremberg (in cooperation with the Academy of Medical Ethics Göttingen).

She was Research Assistant at the Institute for History of Medicine and Medical Ethics at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg and from 2012 -2016 chief executive of the Clinical Ethics Committee(CEC) Erlangen.

Her research topics are Clinical Ethics, Psychiatry and Ethics, Crosscultural Communication and Ethics, Muslim Medicine and Health Care.
